ROTARY CLUBS

Rotary clubs address critical issues by implementing projects. Examples of Rotary's focus areas include:

Polio Eradication - To date, Rotary has contributed more than US\$800 million & countless volunteer hours, and is working with the Bill & Melinda Gates Foundation

International Education - Rotary is the world's largest privately-funded source of international scholarships. Rotary clubs also coordinate student exchange program.

Humanitarian Projects - Rotary clubs initiate thousands of humanitarian service projects every year. These volunteer-driven projects address the root causes of conflict, such as hunger, poverty, disease and illiteracy.

Water Management - Recognizing the importance of clean water, many Rotary clubs help to install wells and develop water treatment and distribution systems to increase access to fresh drinking water for communities in need, especially in developing countries.

MEMBERSHIP PROCESS

Members are expected to attend scheduled club meetings and maintain a 50% attendance record. Missed meetings can be made-up at other Rotary clubs anywhere in the world, or online at e-clubs. Members are required to pay to the club, annual dues which includes administrative costs and dues to district & R.I.

Typically, a prospective member is invited to attend club meetings and activities. The sponsor will then submit the candidate to the club's Board of Directors review. Transferring rotarians are required to submit a letter of good standing from the prior rotary club.
