

TANJUNG DATU NATIONAL PARK 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS



DAY 1 KUCHING / SEMATAN / TELOK MELANO / TANJUNG DATU NATIONAL PARK

0850-0910 hours pick-up from a hotel in Kuching and proceed by road (approx. 2 hours) to the small coastal town of Sematan. Have an early lunch in a local coffee shop or restaurant. Proceed to Telok Melano and transfer boat ride to Tanjung Datu National Park.

Around 1200-1230 hours take a boat (approx. 30 mins) to Tanjung Datu National Park. Arrive at Tanjung Datu National Park HQ around 1330 hours, walk across the beach and settle in at the campsite.

The rest of the day is at your own leisure. Relax on the beach, hike to Telok Upas or Viewpoint trails, have a swim or visit the turtle hatchery. Enjoy dinner at the park HQ. After dark go on a short night walk and search for wildlife such as wild boar, sambar deer, mouse deer, barking deer, civet cats and other nocturnal creatures. Return to the park HQ. Your guide will inform you if any turtles come ashore at night to nest. If so, the rangers will allow you to watch the turtles but only when they have started laying eggs. Please note turtle sightings are not guaranteed. Overnight at the park HQ room or camping shelters.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner

(Note: when the tide is low or sea conditions prevent boat landings at the park HQ, arrival is at a nearby small bay (Telok Upas) followed by a 15 minutes walk to the park HQ.)

DAY 2 TANJUNG DATU NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, around 0800 hours go for a jungle trek along the Pasir Antu Laut trail. Enjoy the forest scenery along the 2.7 km trail and keep a look out for wildlife. Gibbons, banded langurs and hornbills are sometimes spotted on this trail. Midway along the trail you will come to a small stream. Take a short break before continuing through the pristine forest to Antu Laut beach.

Have a swim at the beach before returning along the forest trail. Half way along the trail turn left onto a small track that leads to the main turtle beach. Huge boulders are found along the coast here where the rainforest runs right down to the beach. Admire the views before walking back along the beach to the park HQ arriving around 1300-1400 hours. Have a late lunch at the park HQ. Rest of the day is free at leisure. Go snorkeling near Telok Upas or alternatively go for another walk or relax on the beach.

Dinner at the park HQ. If there is a turtle landing your guide will wake you up during the night. Overnight at the park HQ room or camping shelters. *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 3 TANJUNG DATU NATIONAL PARK / TELOK MELANO / KUCHING

Morning is free in the park. After breakfast, transfer to Kuching. *Meals: Breakfast and Lunch*

Recommended items to bring: Good hiking shoe (Made in Malaysia Rubber Shoes is recommended), raincoat @ poncho, hat, insect repellent, leech sock, sunblock, walking stick (if needed), sleeping bag, sleeping mat, mosquito net, water bottle, toiletries, towel, swimwear, headlight/flashlights, personal First Aid Kit, dry bag packed to carry your personal items.

BAKO NATIONAL PARK 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS



DAY 1 BAKO NATIONAL PARK

0800hours - Pick up from the hotel in Kuching. Bako National Park is situated on a peninsula on the coast and the departure point for trips to the park is Bako village, 35 minutes drive from Kuching. From the village, proceed by boat for approximately 25 minutes to the park headquarters. En-route there is a chance to see crocodiles, sea eagles and other shore birds. Arrive at the park HQ and begin exploring the trails and searching for wildlife with your guide. Have lunch at the canteen and then continue to explore Bako. After dinner at the park restaurant, proceed on a night walk by torchlight. Overnight at the park accommodation.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner

DAY 2 BAKO NATIONAL PARK

Breakfast at the park. Full day exploration of the park in search of wildlife and also trekking to Bukit Pandan to see the pitcher plants. Dinner and overnight *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 3 BAKO NATIONAL PARK / KUCHING

Following breakfast, hike one of the trails to spot rare migratory birds, reptiles, langurs and search for the rare and elusive proboscis monkey, a primate only found in Borneo. We have lunch at the park before returning to Kuching by midafternoon. Overnight at your hotel.

TUBA RADAK JUNGLE CAMP 4 DAYS 3 NIGHTS



DAY 1 KUCHING / SEMENGGOH ORANGUTAN / TUBA LONGHOUSE

Depart Kuching at 8am. Stop at Semenggoh Wildlife Centre enroute to witness the majestic Orangutan in its natural environment. Continue to the Longhouse and meet the locals. Socialise, get to know your surroundings and enjoy the evening of eating, drinking and listening to stories of old. Overnight in the longhouse. *Meals: Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 2 BOAT CRUISE / RADAK JUNGLE CAMP

Early morning wake up. Spend the morning on the river in search of Proboscis Monkeys, Estuarine Crocodiles, Hornbill and a variety of other animals. Stop for tea and biscuits at another Iban community and enjoy a traditional lunch by the side of the river. Head back to the longhouse and transfer to jungle camp. Spend the afternoon exploring the surrounding rainforest and visit a large newly discovered waterfall. Dinner at the camp before going on a night walk in search of any nocturnal activity.

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 3 RADAK JUNGLE CAMP

Spend the day exploring the dense, untouched rainforest. Visit the hidden waterfalls and chill. Dinner at the camp before going on a night walk in search of any nocturnal activity. *Meals: Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 4 RADAK JUNGLE CAMP / KUCHING

After breakfast, enjoy the environment and your final meal here before saying your goodbyes and departing for Kuching. Expect to arrive in Kuching late afternoon.

UKOM LONGHOUSE 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS



DAY 1 KUCHING / UKOM LONGHOUSE

Depart hotel by van then proceed to the Semenggoh Orang utan to observe the semi-wild orangutans during feeding time. Over 20 rehabilitated and locally born orangutans roam this forest reserve and many still return for extra feeding at the stations. Continue for 5 hours to Batang Ai Terminal and continue by native longboat for 1 hour crossing the Batang Ai lake to reach the Longhouse. Pay a courtesy visit to the Headman before exploring the surroundings of the longhouses. While dinner is being cooked, take a dip at the cool Batang Ai River. In the evening, a traditional Iban style dinner, sitting on a mat, will be served at the Headman's room, followed by an evening of native dances, merrymaking, mingling and talking with the Iban hosts. Once the evening is over, retire for the night in the Longhouse.

DAY 2 UKOM LONGHOUSE

After breakfast, try your hands on the blowpipe. A guided nature walk gives you an opportunity to learn about some medicinal plants and agricultural activities of the community, followed by a bamboo picnic lunch by the river. After lunch you will return to the Longhouse for dinner and overnight giving you more opportunity to discuss and compare lifestyle, religion and political attitudes with the local people.

DAY 3 UKOM LONGHOUSE / KUCHING

After breakfast, bid farewell to the people and depart by longboat to the Batang Ai Terminal to continue your journey by road to Kuching. Lunch will be served along the way. Overnight at your hotel *Meals: Breakfast and Lunch*

DELOK BATANG AI 3 DAYS 2 NIGHTS



DAY 1 KUCHING / DELOK LONGHOUSE

Pick up from your hotel. Drive 275km to Batang Ai. Few stops will be made along the journey. First stop will be at Serian town. Serian town's highlight is the native market. Explore the market to identify some jungle products such as local

vegetables and fruits. You may help your guide to purchase some of the items for your supply during the trip. Next stop will be Lachau, a little town for lunch. After lunch, continue the drive to Batang Ai jetty. Upon arrival, proceed by the longboat for 1 hour across Batang Ai Reservoir to Delok Longhouse. Meet the longhouse chief and check in at host family room. Dinner will be at the host family room/chief. Enjoy the evening and relax at Ruai (communal veranda). Listen to stories of the Ibans and learn about their cultures.

Meals: Lunch and Dinner

DAY 2 ORANG UTAN TRAILS

Destination of the day is Jelia River which takes 10 to 20 minutes boat ride from the longhouse. The highlight activity is to trek to one of the trails. Jelia is very well known by a local as a home of the Orang Utan. Nests sometimes can be spotted. Walk in one of the oldest forests in Sarawak is an amazing experience for life. Long tail/ Short tail macaques are occasionally seen in this area. There are varieties of birds that can be seen/heard such as eagle, kingfisher, Asia paradise fly-catcher, pheasant and some other tropical birds. Learn about plants that are used by local for (handicraft, food, medicine). Swimming is available in the river / small waterfall after the trek. You may participate in preparing local BBQ lunch at the riverbank. Proceed back to the longhouse in the afternoon. Free at leisure in the evening/ chat with local. *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 3 DELOK LONGHOUSE / KUCHING

After breakfast, proceed downriver with the longboat for return to Kuching. Lunch en-route.

DAY 4 DELOK LONGHOUSE / KUCHING

After breakfast, take a walk down to Jelia River mouth for pick up by a longboat to Batang Ai boat terminal. Overland transfers back to Kuching. Lunch en-route.

Free at leisure and dinner. *Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 3 TRANSFER OUT

Breakfast before pickup to the airport. End of service. *Meals: Breakfast*

This is also a chance to acclimatize to the heat and humidity of the jungle, before you start trekking in earnest the following day. This evening will be your first night in this amazing environment. Overnight in Penan village. *Meals: Lunch and Dinner*

DAY 2 JUNGLE CAMP - TREKKING

After breakfast, trek 4-5 hours to jungle camp one. Trekking through dense and stunning sections of rainforest, keep your eyes peeled for the amazing wealth of flora and fauna that surrounds you. You and your guides will follow century old hunting trails as well as carving out your own trails in the dense jungle. Make camp food cooked over fire. Sleep in hammocks/Camping

Meals: Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner

DAY 3 JUNGLE CAMP / PENAN VILLAGE

Trek back to the Penan village. In the Penan village there will be time to meet the traditional elders who will be more than happy to discuss their lives. The elders were all born in the forest when their families were still nomadic hunter gatherers, so will provide a truly unique insight into their history and way of life. You will start to learn how to spot animal tracks and bird calls, and as a result there is no doubt that you will start to become at one with the forest as you trek through an incredibly remote area. Overnight in the Penan village.

DAY 4 PENAN VILLAGE / LONG BANGA AIRPORT

6:30am, depart from the village. Take a boat and continue by 4WD to Long Banga. Today is the last day of the expedition. Depending on when your flight is, you may choose to shop. Alternatively, you may choose to stay to discover more sites of Borneo, of which we will gladly point you in the right direction for this. *Meals: Breakfast*
