## 区总监的话

亲爱的扶轮社友和扶青团员

我很难相信已经走进 11 月，也是扶轮年度的第五个月。全球大流行时期带来许多挑战，但我相信你们已经通过创新的解决方案渡过了这场风暴，继续为我们的社区和其他地区服务。一个很好的例子是许多与新冠肺炎疫情有关的应对项目正由各扶轮社承担。我们 3310 地区也不停地继续帮助我们的社区，并寻找其他方案来开展服务项目，包括利用全球奖助金。

至于地区委员会，他们在举办培训，研讨会，竞赛，筹款和其他活动方面都很活跃。扶轮青少年交换和扶轮青少年领袖奖委员会也正在幕后策划虚拟方式的活动。地区秘书和助理总监也一直忙于协调及协助过去 46 次区总监的公式访问。

11 月是我个人最喜欢的月份，因为它是扶轮月历中的**扶轮基金月**。

11 月的主题旨在提醒我们扶轮社员支持扶轮基金会的重要性。当您向扶轮基金会捐款时，您就是直接支持扶轮社的工作。您的捐献使到我们的服务项目（如根除小儿麻痹，促进和平和社区发展）得以实现。迄今为止，您的慷慨捐款不但支持扶轮现有的 6 大焦点领域，也有助于从下一个扶轮年度开始全球奖助金计划中添加的第 7 个焦点领域“支援环境”。您向扶轮基金会慷慨捐献是扶轮社员为人类服务的绝佳方式！







## 社区服务最新信息汇报 – 前社长 Khushroo Dastur 主委

过去几个月里，区域社区服务主委一直在汇集各扶轮社在本扶轮年度已完成或在计划中的服务计划。40 间扶轮社已汇报，2020/21 扶轮年度服务计划的总数将超过 200 多项

目前的 COVID 19 新冠疫情大流行，本地区大多数扶轮社的活动都受到了限制。然而，支援社区里的活动，包括提供膳食、分发个人防护装备或口罩，社友们都积极地参与。本地区有 45 间扶轮社参加了新冠疫情应对战略计划，共执行 38 个服务计划，总值为 RM.863,000 令吉 (\$208,000 美元)。同一时间向 7,800 个家庭提供了粮食援助。也分发了 14,000 份个人防护装备和总数 88,000 个的口罩和面罩。

许多扶轮社积极参与向学校捐赠书籍，笔记本电脑、策划捐血运动和捐赠轮椅等活动来改善社区居民的生活。例如，当距离古晋约 385 公里的 20 间毗连式长屋被大火夷为平地时，古晋中央扶轮社的成员与马来西亚优衣库出手协调将 1,400 件各款式的衣物捐献给居民。

多年来扶轮社一直支持社区服务，3310 地区内一些知名的服务计划项目如洗肾中心，分别由柔佛州新山的六间扶轮社创办并独立管理。此外，莱佛士城市扶轮社于 30 多年前成立的新加坡读写障碍协会，如今已经拥有 14 个中心遍布全岛。还有斯里巴加湾市扶轮社的净水服务计划，亚庇珍珠扶轮社与沙巴州教育部合作在 7 个地点的 16 所郊区学校开设的 REAL (郊区全民注重英语) 服务计划。新加坡甘榜格南扶轮社与 DOT (明日之女) 社团，也不落后也开展一项 MALASAKIT 服务计划，在心态变化和职业指导上，支援单身/年轻妈妈。

3310 地区有很多的扶轮社越来越注重环境。古晋的 5 间扶轮社正在联合实施“清理垃圾净河”项目，以保护生态环境和保持清洁用水。新加坡甘榜格南扶轮社正在与 HEAL 社团合作，绿化中心地带，领航未来的城市农业发展。斯里巴加湾市扶轮社与古晋少数的扶轮社也开展清洁海滩及植树运动。新加坡所有的扶轮社也计划在 2021 年第二季度在新加坡开展类似的植树运动。

携手联合举办服务项目越来越受重视。泗里街扶轮社与泗里街医院合作，为贫困老年白内障患者提供免费人工晶状体 (IOL)，项目的合作伙伴 3310 扶轮网路社捐赠提供 200 个 IOL，另外，为配合世界精神卫生日，裕廊镇扶轮社/新加坡扶轮社联手与新加坡国立大学开展“心灵科学中心”，在社区中宣传“健康老龄化” (AWE) 服务计划。这两间扶轮社还与新加坡室内乐会合上一曲，为尚未出生的婴儿和准妈妈特别创作“母亲交响乐”在线音乐会。还有，东陵扶轮社、裕廊镇扶轮社和甘榜格南扶轮社也与新加坡扶轮社携手合作，分发 FFTH (Food From The Heart) 善心膳食，食物包、蔬菜、水果和鸡蛋等给 59 户家庭。

在关心社区服务的行动中无论是在质和量方面都会有一些扶轮社脱颖而出。它们分别是新加坡扶轮社，3310 扶轮网路社，亚庇珍珠扶轮社，柔佛新山扶轮社，古晋中央扶轮社和斯里巴加湾市扶轮社希望这 6 间活跃的扶轮社看来需下一点功夫，联系较小规模的扶轮社，大家一起联办服务计划。





## 职业服务最新信息汇报 - 创社社长 Tengku Indra 主委

地区职业服务委员会的主要目标是振兴职业服务：即“扶轮的基石”。

### 地区职业服务项目（一）水资源与用水卫生

根据扶轮社的六大焦点领域，委员会想到将这六个服务领域与地区现有专门知识联系起来。为此，委员会已开发了一个名为“地区职业对话”或（DVD）的项目。这项目需要沿着扶轮六个服务领域而辩认出区内的专门知识，并将这项目与扶轮服务领域里无论是现有的或是潜在的项目联系起来。

该委员会于 2020 年 9 月 19 日举办了第一次对话，出席者包括来自甘榜格南扶轮社的用水净化专家 **Bashir Ahmad** 社友。由 Mohan 区总监召开为时两小时的会议里，**Bashir** 社友接受了创社社长 **Tengku Indra** 的采访，主要涉及五个基本问题，这些问题大都涉及地球上的水资源短缺以及如何使用各种技术开发净水系统。

对话之后，前区总监 **Andre Suharto** 与两名扶轮社净化水项目负责人进行了 45 分钟的对话，他们分别是：

斯里巴加湾市扶轮社的前社长 **Wong Chin Toon**

古晋中央扶轮社的前社长 **Ng Yaw Hua**

对话集中在水的净化和卫生项目的几个方面，例如：

- 社区供水和净化评估
- 成员的加入及参与
- 对社区和扶轮社的益处
- 项目的成本和资金

在讨论中，前区总监 **Andre** 相提并论地将扶轮“水资源与用水卫生”领域的重要性与两间扶轮社实施中的有关项目联系起来

这次的 Zoom 视频对话得到扶轮社员的大力支持，共有 73 位与会者在 45 分钟内提出了很多问题。

### 地区职业服务项目（二）疾病的预防和治疗

委员会目前在探讨 11 月份的第二次 DVD 对话。委员会计划在本扶轮年度举办 3-4 次 DVD 对话，并确保这对话项目在 2021-22 扶轮年度及往后的时间里可继续举办。2021 年 1 月份职业服务月里将举行的年度职业服务讲座：

这是委员会计划在本扶轮年度开发的另一个可持续举办的项目，并希望年复一年地举办。对话将会向外界邀请一位杰出的演讲者来谈论“卓越的职业和专业”。委员会正在探讨并期望在 2021 年 1 月启动这项对话。

## **扶轮青少年领袖奖进度报告：前社长 SHINE 主委**

2020 年 7 月 28 日，晚上 8 点举行的 (RYLA) 扶轮青少年领袖奖委员会会议。

会议讨论有关 2020/2021 年区域 (RYLA) 扶轮青少年领袖奖，确认举办的扶轮社与预期挑战。

扶轮青少年领袖奖原来计划在 11 月举行，主办者 3310 扶轮网路社的区助理总监 Richard Ong 告知他所属的扶轮社拒绝了他的建议。

2020 年 9 月 8 日，RC Johor Bahru 柔佛新山扶轮社在希尔顿酒店开例会时，我和助理区总监 Chandran 在会上谈起今年度的扶轮青少年领袖奖。会谈进行的非常顺利。会上提议将 2021 年 3 月或 6 月举办实体扶轮青年领袖奖研习营的主办权发放给柔佛新山扶轮社。

RC Muar 麻坡扶轮社计划在明年 1 月开展一项专为医科学生和医生而设的扶轮青少年领袖奖研习营。

前扶轮青少年领袖奖获奖人的视频会议将定于 11 月 21 日上午 10 点举行。而扶轮青少年领袖奖的视频会议将在 2020 年 12 月 19 日进行。

## **3310 地区扶轮友谊交换委员会汇报 - 前社长 Choo Chor Tek 主委**

3310 地区扶轮友谊交换委员会 (RFE) 急切地期待在本扶轮年度组团回访印度 3030 地区马哈拉施特拉邦。事缘在扶轮友谊交换计划下，在 3030 地区扶轮社员·维拉斯·希罗 (Rotarian Vilas Shirore) 队长的安排下，于 2020 年 1 月 31 日至 2020 年 2 月 6 日，带领 5 对扶轮社员夫妇来马来西亚作友善访问。

但是，由于新冠疫情和 Covid-19 大流行造成的不确定性，回访 3030 区必须暂停。在 Covid-19 大流行期间，所有扶轮友谊交换计划必须被搁置，全世界渴望参与扶轮友谊交换的扶轮社和社员别无选择，只能以虚拟方式进行。

3030 区已同意在 2020 年 12 月的某个时候与 3310 区组织一个虚拟扶轮友谊交换。日期将在适当时候公布。

我们期待参与即将到来的虚拟扶轮友谊交换，并在 Covid-19 疫情后，尽快派遣一个团队到 3030 区进行扶轮友谊交换。
