What we did in 2020 ?

1. The District COL/COR Team was formed and met September 2020.
2. The COLWC started working with the clubs in our District.
3. Secured cooperation from all the clubs to appoint their Club COL representatives.
4. In Oct the COLWC put out recommendation for the 2020 Resolutions and Urgent Enactment to all the clubs.
5. We held the first exercise, our clubs responded and collectively voted the RI 2020 Resolutions and Urgent Enactment.
6. By the first week of Nov 2020 we successfully submitted the District votes.

Preparing for COL/COR work



- Read all of the materials provided by RI website, including the constitutional documents
- Take notes on items and think about which ones are a priority to you and your club & District
- If you have questions, ask COLWC
- Visit RI Websites, read new Resolutions when RI release in end September/early Oct.
- Meet and talk to COLWC representatives for their perspective
- Talk to Rotarians in your club and district for knowledge and feedback on legislation
- Read the Rules of Procedure
- Be open minded, be willing to accept different worldviews, and think globally
- Think about how an item affects all of Rotary, not just your club and your district
- Prepare your club to vote after all views considered and submit to District team timely

3. Review and Prepare Resolutions for endorsement at District Conference.
4. Sept/Oct to prepare for review and submit response to RI COR
5. Early Oct the COLWC will review and put up recommendations.
6. Early November to finalize votes for submission to RI latest by Nov 15
