Why is it important to set goals?

How do long range and annual goals work together?

- Set both long range and annual goals for your committee
- Your long range goals should represent what you want to be in 3-5 years
- Your annual goals will be steps to achieve your long range goals
- As your club evolve so should your goals

What should you consider when setting goals?

- Assess clubs current condition and resources
- Involve members to ensure their commitment
- Research needs of your committee
- Contact DLT for guidance
- Incooperate experience from previous projects and activities
