

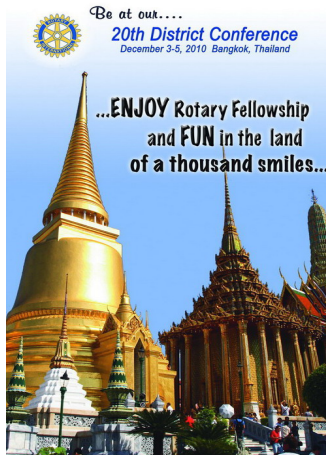

As many of you already know, our **20th RI District 3310 Conference 2010** is to be held at **The EMERALD HOTEL** Bangkok, Thailand from Friday, 3rd to Sunday 5th December 2010.

Located on 99/1 Rachadapisek Road, Din Deang, it is within 2 minutes walk to one of Bangkok's underground (MRT) stations where a 10 to 20 minutes train ride will take you on to well known places like Sukhumvit, Silom, Siam Square or Chatuchak market. Using the MRT and the above ground Sky-train you can also easily get to the Chaophaya River where river cruise boats depart regularly from underneath the station.

The hotel is a 40 minutes drive to Suvarnabhumi International Airport .

The PALAZZO HOTEL which is 3 minutes walking distance from the venue hotel is the alternative accommodation option to enable all budget and preferences to be met.

As this will be the first time our District Conference is to be held outside of District 3310, we promise you it will be ***Truly a conference with a DIFFERENCE !***

Our Hospitality and Guest Activities Committee has prepared a list of activities for you to select and participate in. Welcome Dinner will be held at the Siam Niramit Traditional Thai Cultural Village where you get to attend the world class Siam Niramit Cultural show as part of the conference package.
