1245hrs	Visit the Temple of Dawn (Wat Arun) – oen of the most famous landmarks of Bangkok
1330hrs	Crossing back to Bangkok and board coach for Klong Toey slums to bring cheers to the children at the Mercy Home for Children run by the Human Development Foundation founded by Father Joe Maier in Bangkok's largest slum community (in the event that centre is unavailable, an alternative will be suggested)
1515hrs	Bid farewell and board coach back to hotel
1600hrs	Arrive at hotel
