



<sup>i</sup> Sister Club relationships between Rotary Clubs generally means agreeing to establish a special bond of friendship between the two Clubs for a specified period, subject to renewal by mutual agreement of both clubs. The clubs agree to promote close communications and cooperation with each other regarding projects and activities, planning for a mutually acceptable joint projects and implement and complete at least one such project within the term of the agreement. While a Sister Club agreement implies an obligation between the two Clubs, a Friendship Club agreement generally carry the same objectives without the implied obligation.
