Report on

Joint Districts 3300 & 3310 Seminar on "Seeing Eye to Eye"

The above seminar the fourth in the series was hosted by RC Greentown Ipoh on behalf of District 3300. It was held from 17 to 18 October 2014 in Ipoh.

The organizing committee was chaired by Rtn Dr Lee MunWai an Ophthalmologist himself.

Rotarians from 40 different Rotary clubs from within our two districts attended this event. There was excellent fellowship which was evident throughout the duration of the seminar.

The attendance at this annual seminar has seen a steady growth over the years. This year there were about 250 participants consisting of rotarians, medical students from College of Medicine UNIKL, Perak, Quest University, Institute Pendidikan Guru Ipoh, PersatuanTaska Perak, interactors and members of the public.

Running concurrent to the seminar were two events.

One was an eye screening event where more than 100 people had their eyes screened. This event was hosted by "Lee Eye Centre".

The other event was a simulation of the "world of darkness" of the blind when volunteer members of Adult Blind Association of Selangor engaged members of the public to experience their world of darkness by giving participants a brief glimpse into their world of darkness.

The Guest of Honour was Y. Bhg. Dr Azizahbinti Johor, Special Officer to MenteriBesar Perak DarulRidzuan.

The two Special Guests were District Governor Kirenjit Kaur from District 3300 and District Governor Haji Andre Suharto from District 3310.

Among the highlights at the seminar was the launching of the **National Early Intervention Eye Health Framework** for preschoolers throughout Malaysia.

A briefing on this project was delivered by both PDG David Tong from District 3310 and DGE SitiSubaidah from District 3300.

The GOH officially launched this program.

This is the brainchild of PP DatoBindiRajasegaran from RC Greentown.

The Keynote address was by Dr Rekha Shetty on the theme: "WHO Vision 2020"
