

## **DGE'S MESSAGE TO ALL INCOMING PRESIDENTS**

The current Rotary Year 2017-18 is coming to an end soon and a new term will begin on 1 July 2018. So here are some gentle reminders of things that you will need to do before you start your term. I am sharing the statistics provided by Chonticha Yurai, Senior Officer, Rotary International. Please refer to the tables shown below.

### **1. Registration Rate For Club Officers in Rotary Club Central**

Although we have a 95% registration rate for reporting the position of President, there is still some way to go for the position of Secretary. Please step up the momentum. If these 2 key positions are not reported then correspondence from RI will not reach them.

### **2. Rotary Club Central – Setting 2018-19 goals**

The number of clubs which have set goals in Rotary Club Central is relatively low. In other words there are several clubs which have not done so. During P.E.T.S. you have already been informed of goal setting and the criteria for Presidential Citation. Do refer to the tables in the P.E.T.S./DISTAS magazine (page 32-35) and District directory (pages 1-17) when setting your goals. Setting up the goals is a way of expressing the direction of your Club. This will help you later on to systematically monitor the progress of your Club by comparing what you have achieved against your goals.

### **3. Club Presidents and Secretary With Active My Rotary Accounts**

The statistics show a rate of 85% for Presidents and 76% for Secretaries. There is still room for improvement. My Rotary is a very useful IT platform. Please make use of it urgently.

### **4. New Club Application – Important year-end date**

Do note that RI is approaching the busiest time of the year for Rotary worldwide. So if you are planning to charter a new club within RY2017-18,

please complete and send the applications plus the charter fee to RI before Friday, 8 June 2018.
