- set up on 27 March by DG Jeff Yong
- 10 members from D3310 four Geographical zones

Clear Strategy — 3 pronged program

- (A) Commence District Grants for individual CLUB projects
- (B) Apply for TRF Disaster Response Grant for US\$25,000
- (C) Funding 4 regional GGs for Covid-19 projects

Clear Communication

- comprehensive guidelines
- designated coordinator in each region
- speedy decision process

Covid -19 Response Strategy

(A) District Grants –

Club-driven Projects in local Community:

RM5,000 grants for each club to be matched 1:1

April 1-30 : Approval within 24 hours, Funds disbursed within 48 hours

45 Clubs with 38 Projects

Total Project Value: RM 737,000 (US\$170,000)

Total Subsidy by District: RM207,000 (US\$48,000)

Funded by:

Seed Money from DDRF*: RM100,000 (US\$23,000)

Concurrent Fund raising: RM150,000 (US\$35,000)

Shortfall: RM 57,000 (US\$13,000) excluding seed money

Proposed Fund raising from sale of reusable face masks

PROJECTS' OUTCOMES

(i) Food Aid to Economically Disadvantage Families

RM430,000 or US\$100,000

7,750 families

(ii) PPEs and Medical Equipment

RM162,000 or US\$38,000

14,000 items

(iii) Face Masks, Respirators & Face Shields

RM146,000 or US\$34,000

88,000 items

Covid -19 Response Strategy

(B) TRF Disaster Response Grant

One Grant per District for US\$25,000 (RM107,000)

Only for Covid-19 Response

Submitted 1 day after announcement of program and approved by TRF within 48 hours

Distributed to all Clubs via 5 regions

Singapore Clubs (US\$7,000)

Johor & Melaka (US\$7,000)

Sabah (US\$5,000)

Sarawak (US\$10,000)

Brunei (US\$1,000)

Distributed 50,000 face shields, N95 respirators, disposal and reusable face masks

(C) Global Grant Projects:

Special Covid-19 GG Projects

Waiver of strict GG requirements

48 hours approval

Minimum US\$30,000 per projects - For PPEs, Medical Equipment, Consumables & Food Aid

Funded by:

US\$60,000 DDF from District 3310

4 GGs in 4 regions

Singapore, Johor/Melaka, Sarawak/Brunei, Sabah

(C) Global Grant Projects:

Sabah: Covid-19 Test kits (UD\$31,000 or RM133,000)

Sarawak/Brunei: Medical Equipment and Food Aid
(\$30,000 or RM129,000)

Johor/Melaka: Masks and Sanitizers
(US\$30,000 or RM129,000)

Singapore: PPEs, Supplies for Migrant Workers Covid-19 Isolation Centres and Masks for Community
(\$120,000 or RM516,000)

Covid -19 Response Strategy

PROJECTS IMPACT (financially)

(A) District Grants = RM737,000 or US\$170,000

(B) TRF Disaster Grant = RM107,000 or US\$25,000

(C) Regional GGs = RM907,000 or US\$211,000

TOTAL = RM1,751,000 or US\$406,000

(D) Possible mobilization of a further US\$50,000 via District Grants (RY 2020-2021)
